

To all Persons to whom these presents shall come We
Philip Chase Master & part Owner & Luther Briggs also
part owner, of the Brig Spanish Lady now laying in the
harbour of Norfolk of the burthen of One hundred & twenty
seven tons $\frac{49}{95}$. I bound for St Marys in the State of Vir-
-ginia send greeting. Whereas We are at this time necessitated to
take up upon the adventure of the sd Brig the sum of Two hun-
-dred and twenty one pounds 11/11 Virginia money for setting her forth
to sea & providing & furnishing her with provisions & necessaries for
sd voyage. Now know ye that We do by these presents for our
selves our Exors Adors in consideration of Wm Pennock Merchant
of Norfolk having lent unto & supplied us with sd sum at Six
percent, covenant and grant to & with the said Wm Pennock
that the said Brig shall with the first fair Wind after this day
sail from Norfolk for St Marys, & also that We hereby bind our-
selves our Exors Adors & particularly the said Brig Spanish
Lady with her rigging Tackle & apparel, to pay unto the sd Wm
Pennock his Exors Adors or assigns the said sum of Two hundred
and twenty one pounds 11/11 & Interest within four days after
her arrival at St Marys - and We the said Philip Chase & Luther
Briggs for ourselves our Exors Adors do also covenant & grant
to & with sd Wm Pennock his Exors Adors that at the time of
signing these presents, the said Philip Chase is Master &
hath lawful power & authority as such to bind & charge the
said Brig, which the sd Luther Briggs as part owner also
hath a right to do as far as his part extends - & that all times
hereafter the sd Brig shall be liable for the payment of the said
£221. 11. 11 & Interest after the said voyage according to the
true intent & meaning hereof & lastly it is hereby declared &
agreed by & between the parties hereto, that in case the said
Brig be lost miscarry or be cast away before her arrival at
St Marys - that then the said payment of the said
£221. 11. 11 shall not be demanded or be recoverable
by the said Wm Pennock his Exors Adors or assigns

but shall cease & determine & the loss shall be wholly
borne & sustained by the said Wm Pennock his Executors
& assigns & that from thence forth every matter & thing
herein contained shall cease & be void -
