### TENNESSEE.

PROBABLY the first white people to look upon Tennessee soil were the Spanish cavaliers of De Soto's army in 1541. Reaching the Mississippi, at the site of Memphis, La Salle built Fort Prud'homme 140 years later, on the Fourth Chickasaw Bluff, at the mouth of the French erected Fort Assumption. In 1768 a party of Virginians discovered the Cumberland Mountains named after the Duke of Cumberland. The North Carolinians entered Tennessee as early as 1754, but they were hurried back across the mountains by hostile Indians. Two years later Fort London was founded on the Little Tennessee. In 1761 a little army of Virginians and North Carolinians, under Colonel Grant, crossed the Alleghenies and defeated the savages in several bloody battles, after which they sued for peace. About the year 1770, the strong tide of migration from Virginia and North Carolina began to flow into Tennessee. Settling along the Holston, Watauga and Nolichucky they inaugurated the Royal Government and the Indians. In 1780 a fleet of open boats made an astonishing voyage of 600 miles from Fort Patrick Henry to French Lick, where they founded Nashville. The commander of the fleet was John Donelson, whose daughter (Kachel) married General Andrew Jackson. In 1780, the Tennesseans refused to summon a convention to consider seceding from the Union, but three months later they voted an Ordinance of Secession. Within less than a year a great part of the State was restored to Federal authority, and Andrew Johnson became military governor. Thirty counties of East Tennessee refused to join in secession.

#### ILLUSTRATIONS.

The advance of the French military post along the Alleghenies led to war in 1754, and George Washington led the Virginia troops in an attempt to recover the colony's outposts on the upper Ohio. Virginia took a leading part in the Revolution, and the Declaration of Independence was proposed by one of her deputies. Early in 1861 the people of Virginia, refused by a majority of 60,000, to secede from the Union, but a few weeks later, after blood had been shed, she left the Union.
