

## Gas Inspection

Every gas or electric meter, set of scales, etc., used for measuring goods for sale must be tested and certified accurate before it can be used. This testing is done by the Department of Trade and Commerce.

For every device tested a certificate is issued bearing stamps enough to pay the fees for the tests.

Up until 1930 separate sets of stamps were used for gas and electric meters, but since then the one set does for both meters.

For other devices the Weights and Measures stamps are used.

Red control numbers  $4\frac{1}{2}$  mm. tall










